

Frequently Asked Questions

-How many scholarships are set aside for students and what do they include: tuition, housing, food, local transportation, international transportation?

1. The **two full tuition fee** scholarship covers a complete waive off on the tuition fee and a 50% scholarship on Hostel fees amounting to USD 1000 per year (after Scholarship). This scholarship is applicable for the entire degree course.
2. The charges of airfare and visas will be taken care of by the student.
3. The student would be required to pay monthly electricity charges which will be charged as per the consumption.
4. One-time University admission fee amounts to Rs. 2000 (Indian Rupees) **(OR)** USD 25 approx. subject to revision by the university.
5. College Charges of Rs. 2500 **(OR)** USD 30 approx. would be paid by the students separately which include all books, One day trip, ID Card, Library card, Wi-fi, Lab Facility, Complimentary bus facility from the International hostel and Guesthouse.

-Does the student have the option of living off-campus and if so, what are the costs of living (apartment, food, local transportation, electricity)?

Yes, the student can also choose to stay off-campus. The rent of the apartment depends upon the type of accommodation a student chooses. To give a rough idea, a budgeted PG would cost less than USD 100 per month (food and electricity separate). Usually, electricity is charged as per consumption, if consumed efficiently the bill might be between INR 500 to 700 per month.

-Do students get insurance while attending the programs?

The insurance has to be taken by the student separately. We can help them put through the various companies and then as per their requirement they could choose a medical policy for themselves.

-Regarding hostel or on-campus living, are rooms individual or shared, and does the student get to pick who they share the room with?

We have rooms available in single, double and triple occupancy. Following would be the charges for the room:

- Triple Room - USD 1000 Per Year
- Double Room - USD 1100 per year
- Single Room - USD 1400 per year

It Includes Air Con Room, food (3 meals), Wi-Fi, refrigerator, bed & mattress, curtain, wardrobe, study table & chair. The rooms are allocated to the students as per availability.

-What are the application deadlines and requirements?

The session is expected to start in July month. Therefore, students are requested to kindly apply by June 1st week so that they could work on the visa on a timely basis and join college by July 3rd week.

-Is there an admission fee?

There is no separate admission fee charged to the students. Upon arrival at the college, the student would be needed to pay INR 600 as the registration fee.

-Does PCTE schedule a pick up at the airport for the arriving international student?

With regard to travel from IGI Airport to Ludhiana, we shall be assisting the students. We are in touch with the Indo Canadian bus services which further assist us in the same. The charges for travel ticket would be borne by the students and usually costs around INR 2000 - INR 3000 (less than 30 USD)

-Are your programs divided in semesters and if not, what is the duration of each "semester" and the vacation time in between semesters;

One year is divided into 2 semesters. So, if the degree course is for 3 years then the total number of semesters will be 6. Each semester is for 6 months.
